MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

Full AMUK membership is open to any company which works within the Additive eco-system and is based in the UK. This includes companies which research, develop, supply, or use the technology, and spans the use of materials through to the post-processing and testing of finished parts. Companies providing additive-specific training are also eligible.

Associate AMUK membership is available to companies which do not fit the above criteria, such as trade magazine publishers, banks, marketing companies or advisory services, but which still wish to be part of the AMUK network.

Marketing Intelligence
